### Plan to Succeed

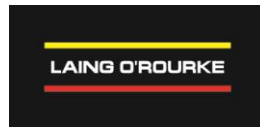
On **Wednesday 25<sup>th</sup> May** there are plans to hold a Jobs Fair at Working Links offices in Cardiff. Candidates will have already received some preparation guidance for this event and will be tasked with a range of actions during the Jobs Fair. What we'd like from contractors:

- Attend the jobs fair with your information stands and marketing “freebies” that you would usually use when attending job fairs.
- Complete an information sheet (provided by us) for each person you speak to.
- Have work trial opportunities or job opportunities available with your company (either on site, in an office or with a supply chain partner etc).
- Make a note of anyone you've spoken to that you think could be suitable for the opportunity/opportunities you are offering.
- Provide a reference for those given a work trial.

**This Jobs Fair is open to all contractors on the SEWSCAP 2 Framework (reserves included)**

On **Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> June** interviews will be conducted by the candidates chosen by the contractors. These are planned to be interviews for the opportunities being offered and would suggest interviewing 2 or 3 people for each opportunity.

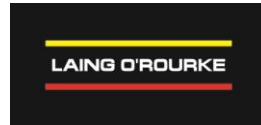
